Including students with significant disabilities in high school is often challenging. This interactive workshop will address practical and promising approaches for developing supports and fostering relationships among students with and without significant disabilities in the classroom and throughout the broader life of the school.

Dr. Carter's projects have focused on (a) implementing peer support strategies as an evidence-based approach for promoting curricular access and social interaction within inclusive classrooms and extracurricular activities and (b) fostering natural supports as an avenue for promoting inclusion in service-learning, after-school, and community activities. This workshop will include activities and strategies from these projects, as well as ideas for launching new efforts within high school.

A portion of the workshop will be devoted to answering questions from any participant currently working to include students with severe disabilities and develop positive peer relationships at the secondary level.
